THURSDAY the students will begin by finding the Same items in each row. They will find and trace the TRIANGLE shapes. Everyone will make a Pilgrim boy or girl. We will make November signs; share our newspapers and our behavior book.

FRIDAY the children will begin with a Before I Write paper. They will find and trace the triangle shapes. The letter is "Z". We will cut on the lines. Most of the class is doing very well with their cutting. We will make a Pilgrim boy or girl, a November sign, share our newspapers and our behavior books.

November 19 and 20 we will learn about Turkeys as we finish our Thanksgiving unit. There is NO SCHOOL the rest of that week.

November 26 our theme is PENGUINS. We will learn
