FRIDAY the class will begin by finding the RHYMING items. They will cut on the lines. The letter is "B". Everyone will cut and paste the square shapes. We will make Indian puppets; share our newspapers and our behavior book.

November 23rd the theme is Thanksgiving and there is NO SCHOOL on the 25th, 26th, and 27th due to the Thanksgiving holiday.

Classes resume on November 30 with a theme of WINTER. SHOW AND TELL will be held on Thursday, Dec. 3rd and Friday, Dec 4th.

The themes for the rest of the month of December will be CHRISTMAS. We will make decorations and gifts. Our annual CHRISTMAS programs and parties will be held on MONDAY, DECEMBER 7th and TUESDAY, DECEMBER 8th at 10am. This is a change of dates to enable Santa Clause to attend all his parties this year.

Students should arrive at the regular class time. Parents and guests should arrive after 9:45am. We will begin at 10am. The students are learning songs and finger plays to share with their families.
