TUESDAY the Bears will begin by finding What Belongs with a Fireman. Their letter is "O". They are doing a super job tracing their letters-working hard to follow those lines. The number is "9" and the story is The Nine Little Kittens. We will travel on our Teddy Bear Corner Train.

WEDNESDAY the class will begin with a dot-to-dot 1-10 to solve. Our letter is "J, j". We will travel on our train.

THURSDAY the students will begin by finding What Belongs in the Refrigerator?

Their letter is "R" to trace. Our Spatial concept word is BETWEEN. We will share our newspapers and behavior books.

FRIDAY we will begin with a 1-10 dot-to-dot to solve. Our letter is "K, k". Our rhyming word is "BEAR". We will cut a rabbit shape. Everyone will share their newspapers and behavior books.

Book orders are due by Friday the 22nd. March tuition is due now.

Each class we will be working on art projects for our Art Show in May. The children will be painting, drawing, coloring, using chalk, markers, clay, salt, etc. as they work on their special treasures.
